

### About the Artist. Early Years

#### Robert John William LANDT.

Born at Warracknabeal, Victoria in 1946 to Robert Aubrey and Elva Jean Landt on WaraWarka (Wergaia) land. Bob came to Adelaide with his parents, brother (Peter Zane) and sister (Coralee Faye) in 1952.

Living at Lockleys, and then Carrington Street Adelaide. Robert's mother encouraged him to paint to occupy his time while ill in bed (1956). The teachers of Gilles St. Practicing School especially Frank S Kealley (editor of the Children's Hour), encouraged Robert greatly.

In 1960 his parents purchased an Automotive Repair Business in Maitland on Yorke Peninsula.

This was a move mainly for the health of the family and a better working environment for Roberts parents. It was a big move for the family. A total change.

Robert's schooling was completed at Maitland Area School where he achieved his Leaving Certificate.

In this new environment he began to take a keen interest in the history and geology of Yorke Peninsula. Teacher Cletus McEntee encouraged his interest. While at school he formed a Geology Club. (Maitland and District Junior Geology Club, MDJGC). This met once a month for several years and had Warner Brothers kind permission to use Fred Flintstone as a mascot and emblem.

Wandering over "The Crooked Leg", (Yorke Peninsula) with Garth Brown (Minerals) and David Hill (History of the Aboriginal communities of Yorke Peninsula), increased his interest in all things about him, especially the landscape, colour, light and shade.

In 1962 Robert won prizes for watercolour at the Wallaroo Art Show.

In 1962, 63, 64, 65 he won prizes for Most Outstanding Exhibitor at the Maitland Show.

In 1965 Robert became a State Finalist in the "Albert Namatjira Memorial Art Prize". This prize was founded by Joyce D Batty, feature writer, author and adventurer. Mr. Reg Campbell, (well known NSW Artist) judged the paintings.

In 1966 Robert again entered the "Albert Namatjira Memorial Art Prize", with the painting "Jungaburra" (A Spirit Place). Mr. Claude Hotchin, O.B.E. noted art critic and Philanthropist said of Roberts painting. " This painting conveys a definite message and I feel a strong spiritual quality. I feel Robert will go a long way if encouraged."

"Robert paints in a way that will make people want to come back."

Going to Brisbane for the presentation of awards, Robert had discussions with the other artists regarding their styles and thoughts on trends in the arts. Being self taught this greatly added to his interest and experimentation with his work. The type of paper and multiple washes in water colour became important to him, especially after several visits to Harold Thomas (1967), who woke him up to the works of J. J. Hilder an early Australian water colourist. (Harold the creator of the Aboriginal Flag was then known as Joseph Wallace).

At Brisbane Robert was presented with the Albert Namatjira Memorial Prize Founders Award by Joyce D Batty. In Joyce's notes of the Brisbane trip, she wrote," I think he feels more emotion than he observes, and this is probably because he is self taught and has none of the frustrations of art teachers. He is therefore not disillusioned by modern concepts which art school instil in impressionable youngsters".

Robert exhibited works in Adelaide, Melbourne, Sydney, Alice Springs and Brisbane during the late 1960's as well as The Advertiser Open Air Arts Festival.

In the 1967, the Maitland All Car Club (MACC), was Formed. Robert was a founding member and served in most positions. It was mainly to encourage sports motoring events and better driving. It was a great success for many years catering to several generations on Yorke Peninsula. It ran several major rallies on Yorke Peninsula. Robert was also a CAMS steward for a time.

In 1971 he held an exhibition of paintings to assist the development of the CYP Branch of the National Trust as the founding Secretary. The exhibition was a sell out with a further 48 commissions for new work . This got the Branch off to a good start.

Bob's Paintings hang in many homes in South Australia and Victoria, some have been sold to the USA, South Africa, and Germany as well as several travelling to Nepal with home sick Australian Doctors.

In 1970 Robert married Jennifer O'Brien who encouraged him to further paint, however, the purchase his parents business in 1974, designing and building a house, as well as establishing a family greatly restricted his for time for painting.

In 1972 Rhoda Heinrich asked Robert to help in illustrating her book, "Governor Fergusson's Legacy", a book on the history of Yorke Peninsula. The book was officially launched in 1972 with illustrations by Margaret Brown and Robert exhibited for sale.

Mr. Tom Cotton of Gillingham Printers wrote to Robert after the release and said," Your drawings were in my office for such a long time I felt I knew you".

1974 was the year that Robert joined Jaycees, (Junior Chamber International) and promoted the need for an art and craft fair to promote and encourage local Yorke Peninsula people to be active in their chosen interests. The fair ran for fifteen years. For his long service to Jaycees in nearly all positions as well as Great Northern Regional President he was appointed as a Life Member of the Maitland Chapter on his retirement at 40 years old.

Robert became involved in the 70's on a number of boards and committees. Y.P. Tourism, The Village, Community Development.

Other exhibitions in which Robert was involved were for Greg Judd, (art teacher Maitland area school), Bob McKnight, (local engineer who was highly talented in oils and pottery) and the Maitland Show as convener.

1979 Robert was appointed a Justice of the Peace for South Australia and a Local Coroner 1992, Now retired after more than 25 plus years of service.

Bob foundered the Maitland Auto Preservation Society (MAPS), due to his interest in vintage Studebaker motor vehicles. This is still going strongly today with a membership from all over the Peninsula.

1990 led to the creation of a Museum for the Maitland Auto Preservation Society. This was called "The Garage", and was designed by Bob to be set up as a U shaped street with shop fronts on four sides, the windows as display cases with meeting rooms and show areas all inside the building. The project took twelve years to complete with supervised people from a correctional services Programme and many wonderful local volunteers. Of special mention were Morris Climpson, Eugene Darmody and Gordon Dutschke.

The car club transferred "The Garage", to the Maitland Progress Association to set up for week end markets and community and tourism promotions. (MAPS members at the time didn't have the man power to keep "The Garage", open). In 2008 Bob was invited to set up his Gallery at the Maitland Markets and often paints there as the artist in residence..

1997 encouraged by Joyce McKnight whose husband Bob had passed away, Robert began to take up the brush seriously again. He coordinated and hung an exhibition of Bob McKnight's works for the dedication of the McKnight Theatre at Maitland. Other works were included by well known Yorke Peninsula artists and the event was a great success.

1998, 50 works were completed for the first major solo exhibition by Robert in many years. It was called "The Three Mums", dedicated to Robert's mother Elva, Mother in-law Brenda O'Brien and Joyce Batty who had played a major roll in his artistic life. The exhibition held in Maitland consisted of mainly water colour landscapes, the subjects coming from South Australia, Victoria and Tasmania.

2001 Robert joined the Royal South Australian Society of Arts. He has been very active on the Council as a member and Vice President. In 2005 he became editor as of the "Kalori", the news letter for the RSASA.

2002 led to the creation of the "Corner Gallery" in Jennifer and Roberts automotive Garage at 1 Elizabeth Street Maitland. It was opened by Joyce Batty and proved to be a great success in the community, Artists were encouraged to have exhibitions and Country Arts travelling shows were also presented. Exhibitions covered also NADOC and SA Living Artist's Week. Bob also taught water-colour classes to locals and more distant beginner and experienced artists.

Robert retired from the business "Bob Landt's" in 2008 and has been active in the RSASA, U3A, and Maitland Markets. Generally he paints in watercolours or sketches every day. He has also self published a series of books on the experiences of "POP" for his grandchildren and taken an interest in photography.

Moved to Renown Park Adelaide in 2018.



# "You can't be an artist, you're a motor mechanic!" (J M Williams "OUTBACK" magazine: Article April 2008).

I don't know how many times people have commented on the fact that you obviously can't paint a picture if you can fix a car. I was painting well before taking on an apprenticeship as a motor mechanic in 1964. I won a number of prizes at shows and exhibitions too.

It all stated when my parents bought a mechanical workshop in Carrington St., Adelaide. I was a skinny bespectacled runt who spent a lot of time at home sick.

My mother Elva like most Mums wanted to give me something to do and she being very good at sketching, thought a paint set would be ideal to show off her talented son. Sitting up in bed I found inspiration for a painting in an English book on travelling. A painting of a village soon appeared with thatched roofed cottages and a bubbling brook in the foreground.

Mum was so thrilled she even invited the local priest, Father Witt, over to see the painting. Dad tongue in cheek, immediately took credit for the talent being in his side of the family. My brother and I were both in strife as the priest had to step over a half full chamber pot to see the amazing work which was displayed in our bed room Not Half the trouble Dad was in after the visitor left, for taking credit for the artistic ability of his second child.

Encouraged by my parents and teachers of Gilles Street School, I enjoyed painting so much that any chance for a moment with the brush was taken. School projects and books became a venue for experimentation and new views of studied subjects.

In 1960 we moved to Maitland and the new environment encouraged painting still Further. Then 1964 was the year I became an artistic motor mechanic in my fathers business.

My thoughts on art are that it is an expression of what I see in the work I'm creating and how I would like to show or explain those feelings about the subject being painted. Expressing one's self via a media to show others what you are seeing both with your eyes and in your soul.

You can be an artist and a motor mechanic, you can be anything you want, if you try.


